TONNAGE FOR FRANCE

Extensive Work in Hand in British Yards

FIRST OF THREE MOTORSHIPS LAUNCHED AT GOVAN

From Our Own Correspondent GLASGOW, Friday

Reference to the part Britain was playing in the rebuilding of the French merchant fleet was made in the speeches which followed the launch of the cargo motorship La Hague, under construction for the French Government by Harland & Wolff, Ltd., Govan, yesterday afternoon. La Hague is the first of a group of three cargo vessels of 4450 tons gross to be built and engined at Govan. Madame Loranchet, wife of the Director of the French Mercantile Marine, performed the naming ceremony.

Mr. Louis V. Dunlop, managing director of the Govan yard of the builders, proposed the toast of the new ship and said that she would form another link between France and the British Commonwealth. The three vessels ordered by the French Ministry of Transport would be a very substantial contribution to the rehabilitation of French sea power, the development of her Colonies and the restoration of her overseas carrying trade. It was fortunate that the French Ministry placed their valuable shipbuilding orders in this country in 1945, as that had enabled British shipbuilders to give them reasonably early delivery. British shipyards, Mr. Dunlop stated, have on order or are at present building for French account 92 vessels of over 117,000 tons gross of all types, such as passenger liners, cargo liners, colliers, dredgers and coastal tankers. These orders, the value of which was approximately £11,500,000, would be delivered steadily from now onwards and throughout 1947 and 1948. They were most welcome additions to the volume of British exports.

CONGESTION AT SANTOS

25 Per Cent. Surcharge on Freights

The United Kingdom/Brazil Conference Lines have informed shippers that, in view of serious congestion in the port of Santos and consequent heavy delays and expenses to vessels discharging there, it has been found necessary to impose a surcharge of 25 per cent. on the freight on all cargo destined to that port. The surcharge will come into operation in respect of shipments by vessels commencing to load on and after Oct. 1 next.

The lines concerned are Blue Star Line, Ltd., Thos. & Jas. Harrison, Lamport & Holt Line, Ltd., Pacific Steam Navigation Company and Royal Mail Lines, Ltd.

The United States Freight Conference applied a surcharge of 25 per cent. on freight rates from Santos to United States Atlantic and Gulf ports on Sept. 1.

SHIPYARD WORK

Machinery for New Strick Steamers

The propelling machinery of the two 11,000-ton cargo and passenger steamers just ordered from John Readhead & Sons, Ltd., South Shields, by Frank C. Strick & Co., Ltd., will consist of reciprocating steam engines working in conjunction with a Bauer-Wach exhaust turbine. The new vessels will differ from the three already under construction at South Shields (Nigavistan, Tabaristan and sistership), of which the Turkistan and Afghanistan are the prototypes, by being larger and faster (14½ knots, compared with 12 knots), and by having water-tube boilers in place of Scotch boilers.

MERSEY DOCK WORK SCHEME

Voluntary Proposals Fail

From Our Own Correspondent LIVERPOOL, Friday

A leaflet appeal to dockers in the Transport and General Workers' Union to stand by their union and to fight those who would destroy unity was circulated among dockers on Merseyside to-day. The leaflet, which is signed by Mr. Arthur Deakin, general secretary, and Mr. John Donovan, docks group secretary, refers to attempts to split the unity of the dockers and declares that "dockers are not going to fall for this stunt."

The leaflet states that the unions have submitted proposals to the employers claiming that permanent schemes should be under the joint control of unions and employers, that men should receive payment for any half-day they are available for work, and that there should be a minimum guarantee of £4 16s. a week.

"The employers have rejected our claims," states the leaflet, "and propose that the schemes shall be under the sole control of the port authorities (in Liverpool the Mersey Docks and Harbour Board), who would decide how many men were to be registered, the men to receive £16 for each four weeks, all earnings, including overtime, to count against the guarantee. The unions have rejected the employers' terms."

"We have reported this to the Minister of Labour, who has decided to appoint a committee of inquiry to examine the position and report to him in order that he may proceed to prepare his own scheme as provided in the Act. We are preparing our case for this inquiry and arrangements are being made for a national docks delegate conference to receive a report."

INSURANCE INSTITUTE OF LONDON

At the annual general meeting of the Insurance Institute of London, held yesterday in the Conference Hall, 20, Aldermanbury, Mr. C. H. Leach (Northern Assurance) was installed president for the ensuing year, and Mr. J. W. Berry (Royal Insurance) was elected deputy-president. A vote of thanks to Mr. Neville Dixey (Lloyd's), the retiring president, was moved by Sir Arthur Morgan (London Assurance), who expressed the Institute's regret that Mr. Dixey's illness prevented his attendance. The Lloyd's influence in the Institute, he said, was not so strong as that of the companies, but Mr. Dixey had brought to the Institute the "revivifying blood" of a great institution. Mr. W. I. Featherstonehaugh (Commercial Union) retired from the office of hon. treasurer, and he was presented with an inscribed gold wristlet watch as a mark of appreciation for his 12 years of service. Mr. A. S. Noyes (Northern Assurance) was elected hon. treasurer.

BELGIUM TO NEGOTIATE FOR CANADIAN WHEAT

BRUSSELS, Friday

Major Paul Kronacker (Belgian Minister for Imports) will leave for Canada on Sept. 24 in order to negotiate an agreement for Canadian wheat.—Reuter.

ROYAL SEAMEN'S PENSION FUND

Last Year's Increased Grants

The report of the governing body of the Royal Seamen's Pension Fund for 1945 states that Mr. W. Everall, Mr. W. R. Roberts, Mr. W. G. D. Holloway, Mr. C. McVey and Mr. J. H. Tarbitton were reappointed members of the governing body for the three years ending Dec. 31, 1948. Vacancies caused by the resignations, through ill-health, of Captain H. Salvesen and Commander F. W. Hawkrige, were filled by the appointment of Mr. H. Hogarth and Mr. A. Robertson.

The total income for the year 1945 was £118,584, which continues the increase reported last year. In the second world war the British Merchant Navy suffered very serious losses, and there has been a decrease in the number of foreign domiciled seamen employed. Nevertheless, the governing body regard the financial position of the fund as satisfactory, but the persistent reduction in the rates of interest on trustee securities, to which they are restricted in the investment of their funds, causes them some anxiety. The benefits of an official policy of cheap money do not extend to trustees and others acting in a similar fiduciary capacity. The governing body await with some apprehension the position of the fund when the National Insurance Bill becomes law.

During the year the number of applications for pensions under Class A (seamen with not less than 24 years' service in foreign-going ships) was 208, compared with 186 in 1944, the number of pensions awarded being 162 (144 in 1944). Under Class B (all other seamen, including fishermen), the number of applications was 230 (186 in 1944), of which 74 (71) were successful. Expenditure on pensions was £73,707 in 1945, against £66,053 in 1944.

EFFECT OF INCREASED PENSION

The conclusion of the war lessened the demand for the services of many of the older seamen, and not only has the successive decrease in the number of applicants been arrested, but there are signs that the demand for pensions may before long reach pre-war level. The rise in the expenditure on pensions in 1945, though mainly caused by the additional sum of 2s. 6d. a week granted on Apr. 1, 1945, to Class A pensioners, was to some extent due to the restoration to the effective list of many pensioners who had found during the war opportunities for employment, both afloat and ashore. This increase of 2s. 6d. a week in the value of the pension was in many cases offset by a reduction in the amount of the supplementary pension. Representations were therefore made to the Ministry of National Insurance that the aggregate amount which a pensioner might receive from outside sources without reduction of his supplementary pension should be increased from 10s. 6d. to 15s. a week. The Ministry undertook to give consideration to the matter.

It has hitherto been the consistent policy of the governing body not to accept voluntary contributions. The widow of a pensioner bequeathed the sum of £495 to the fund. The governing body, after careful consideration of the matter and having ascertained that the acceptance of a voluntary contribution was permissible under the Royal Charter of Incorporation, decided to depart from their previous policy to the extent of accepting spontaneous contributions but not in any circumstances to make an appeal for such contributions.

Grants amounting to £2021 were made during the year to institutions making provision for seamen. A statement of the balances of the fund shows that since its establishment the total income to Dec. 31, 1945, was £3,339,753, of which £1,738,094 has been paid in pensions to seamen and £28,941 in grants to seamen's institutions.

TRANS-CANADA LINES TO USE LONDON AIRPORT

As from to-morrow the Canadian Government transatlantic service will be extended from Prestwick to the London Airport. Trans-Canada Air Lines, which started operating the Canadian Government service in 1943, have for some months been flying a daily service between Montreal and Prestwick. The Prestwick route will continue to be used by Trans-Canada Air Lines, and the initiation of flights from the London Airport will give passengers, mail and freight a more convenient through carriage from London.

RUBBER CARGO DIVERTED TO LIVERPOOL

The City of Tokio, 6993 tons gross, now homeward bound from Singapore with a cargo of rubber, has been diverted from London to Liverpool, and the vessel is due in the Mersey to-morrow. This diversion has been necessitated because available specialised accommodation in the London docks for rubber has recently been filled by large consignments arriving from the Far East. It is understood that the P.L.A. are taking steps to make available additional accommodation for rubber.

ARGENTINE CONSULAR FEES

Shippers are informed that notification has been received from the Argentine Consul-General in London that all Consular fees applicable to clearance of ships including bills of lading, parcel receipts and Consular invoices, will in future be collected by the Argentine customs authorities at port of destination in Argentina, but such documents will still require to be presented to the Argentine Consulates for certification.

COAST LINES APPOINTMENT

Mr. Cecil E. Hulme has been appointed passenger manager of Coast Lines, Ltd., and associated companies at Liverpool in succession to Mr. William McNaughton, who has recently retired. Starting as a junior in the Belfast office of the Belfast Steamship Company 30 years ago, Mr. Hulme was transferred to the passenger department of Coast Lines at Liverpool in 1926. Mr. Hulme has a wide experience of the passenger service between England and Ireland and also of the coastal cruises which were popular before the war and are likely to be resumed next year.

FREIGHT MARKETS

Miscellaneous Business

By Our Own Correspondent THE BALTIC, Friday A fair amount of business has again been arranged in the chartering market, but in spite of that fact orders in many directions are accumulating. There has been a resumption of grain chartering from up-River to Antwerp, while an interesting development has been the conclusion of business for wheat from Montreal to Rio Janeiro. Further space has been arranged for phosphate from Casablanca to Australia on the basis of recent values, according to loading date, and other business is known to be treating. On time charter basis another large ship has been fixed for delivery Manchester for the trip out to the Eastern Mediterranean at 16s. 9d.

River Plate charterers are displaying a little more interest, and a medium-sized Greek vessel for Oct. 31 cancelling has been fixed from not above Rosario to Antwerp at \$18, with options, and tonnage is being offered for similar business. There is also some inquiry for Sweden. Vessels of about 8000 tons for September loading are required from Santos to Gdynia for coffee, and from Santos/Montevidéo to Kowloon for rice, the rate indicated for the latter business being \$28. f.i.o. Tonnage is reported to have been arranged for nitrate from Chile to the Middle East.

In the North American section an interesting development has been the fixing of two large American vessels for wheat from Montreal to Rio Janeiro for the second half of this month at \$14. Further tonnage might be worked for grain from the St. Lawrence, there being firm orders to Rotterdam and to the East and West Coast of India. Numerous orders are circulating for coal from the Northern Range for various destinations, and Gulf exporters are asking for offers for various classes of cargo. Further tonnage might be worked for sugar from Cuba.

There are no reports of any further bookings having been arranged for coal from Calcutta or ore from Vizagapatam. Further tonnage is treating for coal from Durban, and there is a maintenance of the demand for phosphate and salt from the Red Sea ports. There has been a continuance of the demand for phosphate from Casablanca to Australia, and another two vessels have been fixed, 82s. 6d. being repeated for Sept. 30 cancelling and 72s. 6d. for October. It is understood that tonnage is on the point of being fixed from Cagliari to Antwerp. Spanish Mediterranean salt exporters have many unfilled orders.

PROVINCIAL REPORTS

By Our Own Correspondents LIVERPOOL, Friday With the continued shortage of carriers, only small response is possible to the active early and forward demand for miscellaneous trades in all sections. In outward coal a licence is reported refused for a vessel from Wales to Oran/Algiers at 22s. 6d.

CARDIFF, Friday Outward foreign chartering is quiet with only a small number of orders quoting. Home coasting activities are on moderate lines, but coals are still difficult to arrange.

SWANSEA, Friday Business is still proceeding very slowly, since even in the short home trades, where small tramp steamers are amply available, chartering is checked by stemming difficulties. Elsewhere the scarcity of coals is restricting operations.

NEWCASTLE, Friday North European and near Continental inquiry is steadily maintained, but the tightness of coal cargoes keeps trading at a standstill; tonnage is scarce. Home coast inquiry is brisk, but September tonnage is scarce and stems are well earmarked. The coaling ports are bare of orders.

HULL, Friday Coasting and short sea tonnage is in short supply and a firmer tone is evident. Handy-size tonnage is still wanted for Spain and Portugal. Fixture:—WEST ITALY (ldg. Humber).—3900 t., 27s., Sept. 25.

GLASGOW, Friday About the only orders quoting are in the home coasting section, where the accumulation due to tonnage scarcity is as big as ever. September allocations of coal to overseas destinations are well covered and again only residues will accrue to this market. The Control Commission needs ships from Antwerp, Rotterdam and Emden to Greece, French North Africa, Denmark, Portugal, Italy and Scandinavia.

INTERNATIONAL MONETARY FUND

Exchange Transactions Early Next Year

WASHINGTON, Friday M. Camille Gutt, managing director of the International Monetary Fund, announced here last night that the 39 member Governments of the fund had been asked to communicate to the fund within 30 days the par values of their currencies. After the fund and members have agreed on the par values, the fund will begin exchange transactions, probably early in 1947, said M. Gutt.

"Par values must be expressed in gold or in United States dollars based on the rates of exchange that prevail 60 days before the fund agreement went into effect," said M. Gutt. "The fund will sell to a member for its own currency or gold foreign exchange which it needs to make payments for imports and other current transactions. Foreign exchange sold by the fund for members' currency will be repurchased by the member under specified conditions. In this way the fund will help members to maintain stable and orderly exchange arrangements." —Reuter.

U.K.-AUSTRIAN TRADE

The Austrian Trade Delegation, having completed their discussions with the Board of Trade, are now returning home. The talks, which were designed to explore the possibility of developing trade between the two countries within the framework of the recently concluded Payments Agreement, and were not aimed at the conclusion of any formal trade agreement, have ranged over the possibilities of Austria exporting to this country various goods needed here, including timber and timber manufactures, the prospects for the supply to Austria from the United Kingdom and the rest of the sterling area of raw materials and other goods urgently needed by Austria, the extension to Austria of the "token" import arrangements and the possibilities of allowing import from Austria of various manufactured goods traditionally exported by Austria to the United Kingdom. The amount of timber Austria can offer for export to the United Kingdom is limited by availabilities and other demands. A final decision as to the extent to which Austria can supply timber to the United Kingdom will be taken by the Austrian Government on the return of the delegation.

MONEY MARKET

Treasury Bill Result

The £150 million of three months' Treasury bills offered at the Bank yesterday were allotted at an average rate of 10s. 2.08d. per cent., against 10s. 2.04d. per cent. last week. The total amount applied for was £299,450,000, and applicants at £99 17s. 5d. for the bills to be dated next week will receive about 30 per cent. Next Friday the maximum amount to be issued will again be £150 million, and there will be a T.D.R. call for £80 million.

In Lombard Street there was again a good demand for overnight loans, which proved to be in short supply, so that borrowers experienced some difficulty in satisfying their needs. There was only a small demand for short dated Treasury bills on the part of the banks. Consequently the market was again compelled to seek the assistance of the special buyer. Foreign exchange rates and silver prices were steady.

STOCK EXCHANGE

Quiet though Firmer

There was a marked falling off in the volume of Stock Exchange business yesterday, but in spite of that fact the tone was firmer. In the gilt-edged section active buying of British Government stocks was in evidence, and prices were finally 1-16 to 3-16 up where changed, the larger movement being shown in the old Consols to 97 1/2 and the 3 per cent. Funding to 105 11-16. The only quotable change among home railway Ordinary stocks was a fall of 1/4 to 60 in London Transport "C." Argentine railway issues were supported, on reports of a new trade agreement being reached with this country.

A decidedly firmer tone ruled in the market for shipping issues. The feature was the strength of Furness, Withy, which jumped 2s. to 32s., while gains of 6d. were shown in Coast to 20s., Cunard to 32s., Elder Dempster to 41s. 6d., France, Fenwick to 54s., P. & O. Deferred to 54s. 6d., Royal Mail to 27s. and Union-Castle to 29s. 6d.

In the shipbuilding, iron, coal and steel group transactions were on a smaller scale, and the tone was firm except for a drop of 1s. 6d. to 46s. 9d. in Dorman, Long. A demand sprang up for Lambert Brothers, following the increased distribution, dealings taking place at 80s. to 82s. 6d. Bolsover Colliery rose 7 1/2d. to 56s. 7 1/2d., Powell Duffryn 6d. to 24s. and Staveley to 53s. 1 1/2d.

Public interest in commercial and industrial issues was on a reduced scale, and usually prices fluctuated within narrow limits and showed no decided tendency. Among oils gains of 1-32 were shown in Anglo-Iranian to 4 29-32, Burmah to 3 15-32, Shell to 4 1/2 and V.O.C. to 3 23-32.

THE COAL TRADE Special Market Reports. From Our Own Correspondents CARDIFF

There is no easing in demand and strong conditions rule. Support is actively maintained for practically all descriptions, but there is still an extremely tight supply position and further business for this month is not easily placed. Everything among the top qualities is reserved for home use.

SWANSEA Big quantities of anthracites continue to be sought by Continental importers, but in view of the pressing requirements of home consumers very little free coal is available for export.

NEWCASTLE The market displays an active forward tone, all classes of consumers being anxious as far as possible to cover early winter requirements. There is some overseas inquiry, but actual shipments total under 5 per cent. of all trade being done, and even then comprise lower grade and open-ast coal; most of the trade is of parcels for Eire and Scandinavia.

HULL The scarcity of supplies available for early delivery remains acute and business is still strictly limited. There is active demand from home consumers, but collieries have full order books from priority users for the whole of this month's potential output. Cokes are well engaged with inland orders.

MERSEY The bunker position shows a slight improvement. The coastwise section is active for all classes of fuels, but exports are still on a small scale for foreign destinations.

GLASGOW The weather is interfering with open-cast production so that supplies for the domestic depots are less. Large coal is difficult to obtain in view of, heavy railway tonnages and allocations to the domestic market.


