

## Mayor of the City of Boston:

SIR, — In compliance with the ordinance relative to the Weighers and Inspectors of Vessels and Ballast Department, I herewith report that for the year ending Jan. 31, 1901, we have weighed, marked, and inspected three hundred and twenty-one vessels (321), and their cargoes delivered by them amount to thirty-eight thousand two hundred and ninety-nine (38,299) tons. The fees amount to nineteen hundred and fourteen dollars and ninety-five cents (\$1,914.95). Expenses of office for year, eighty dollars and ninety-nine cents (\$80.99). Net income, \$1,833.96. The net income has been divided by incumbents.
